95/15 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Council was addressed regarding the A30 road diversions and most specifically traffic movements on Shell Woods.

96/15 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies were received and accepted from the following Councillors:-

97/15 DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

98/15 POLICE REPORT

PCSO Andrea Crocker apologized for being unable to attend the meeting and advised that the only crime reported for the month of July is non payment of fuel at Penlan Garage.

99/15 CORNWALL COUNCILLOR REPORT

Cornwall Councillor Batters reported on his meeting with Cornwall Council earlier in the afternoon regarding the A30 traffic arrangements.

100/15 HIGHWAYS & FOOTPATHS

Councillor Montague reported that a number of potholes have been filled at Temple.
 Councillor Mrs Pope advised that the fingers of the broken Tresarrett wooden sign have been located but are damaged.

101/15 A30 TEMPLE TO HIGHER CARBLAKE LIAISON MEETING & SHELL WOODS

Councillor Fairman read Councillor Mrs Carey's liaison meeting report to Council.
 It was proposed by Councillor Bogle and seconded by Councillor Mrs Webber that Standing Orders are suspended to allow the Council to take further comments from the public present. This proposal received the support of the Council.

The Council received further comments on the implementation of a one way traffic system on Shell Woods and the traffic monitoring system.

It was proposed by Councillor Mrs Pope and seconded by Councillor Montague that the meeting is reconvened and Standings Orders enforced. This proposal received the support of the Council.

Cornwall Councillor Batters advised the Parish Council that at his meeting with Cornwall Council earlier in the afternoon Cornwall Council requested that Blisland Parish Council votes on the proposal to implement a two week one way traffic system at Shell Woods.

It was proposed by Councillor Fairman and seconded by Councillor Bogle that Blisland Parish Council supports the implementation of a two week one way traffic system at Shell Woods subject to the trees from the A30 Fourwinds junction to Merrymeeting being trimmed back sufficiently to allow the clear passage of lorries and that traffic assessment and monitoring is undertaken for the full period. This proposal received the support of the Council.
