A30 Bolventor to Colliford westbound resurfacing

Highways England operates, maintains and improves England's motorways and major A roads. I am writing to let you know that we will shortly be carrying out roadworks near to you. A map detailing the location is included within this letter.

The works

Inspection has revealed the road surface of the A30 westbound carriageway from Bolventor to Colliford has deteriorated and needs to be resurfaced. By carrying out this work now, we will maintain the network in good condition for our customers and avoid the need for disruptive unplanned closures in the future. We would like to apologise in advance for any noise disturbance which may occur.

When

A30 Bolventor to Colliford westbound – 6 February to 27 February 2018

Hours of work: Overnight 7pm to 6am

Traffic management and diversion route

Mainline carriage way works will be carried out under overnight lane closures and a convoy system will be in place. It will also be necessary to close the following slip road and junctions overnight:

- **7 February 2018 – Bolventor on-slip overnight closure** – traffic wishing to join the A30 WB via the on-slip will be diverted to join the A30 EB at Bolventor and onto the WB carriageway via the A30 Fivelanes junction.
- **16 February 2018 – Colliford junction overnight closure** – traffic wishing to leave the A30 WB at this junction will be signed, in advance, to leave the A30 at Bolventor and will follow the local roads around Colliford lake to their destination. Those missing the advance signing will be diverted onto St Breward Junction and will return via the A30 EB to Bolventor. A30 EB traffic wishing to use the gap will be signed onto the Bolventor junction to follow the local roads around Colliford Lake
- **20 - 21 February 2018 – Temple junction overnight closure (exit and entry slip)** – traffic wishing to leave the A30 at this junction will be diverted on the A30

to leave at St Breward's Junction. Traffic wishing to enter the A30 will be diverted onto the St Brewards Junction

We always aim to work to the programme, however **unforeseen circumstances may mean slight changes to it**. We will always aim to notify you of any major changes within the programme but please monitor www.trafficengland.com to keep up to date.

We would like to apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause you. We will make every effort to ensure the impact on the local community and travelling public is kept to an absolute minimum.
