1. Matters arising

JS and CC had met with St Breward regarding use of the village community bus. There will be no problem picking up residents from Blisland if requested. It could also be available to hire for any club excursions etc, but it would be preferable to also hire the designated driver. JS will publicise the scheduled timetable on the parish email when the PC have discussed it;

Settlement Boundary: SM spoke to the Planning Officer dealing with the request for Pre-Application Advice for the area of land opposite the Village Hall; the Planning Officer advised that, on the evidence he currently has, the response to the Pre App will be to the effect that it would be unlikely a formal application for a dwelling on this site would be approved.

2. Project Plan

Plan largely on track with some outstanding actions:

LC to arrange to consult with Parochial Church Council re issues and opportunities from the PCC perspective. One issue could be planting and screening of proposed graveyard extension.

KD to consult with school. Also follow up regarding views of local parents on need for more play facilities.

Re consultation with Commoners, KD to ask DA for advice on issues and questions; SM to then speak DF.

SM to consult Blisland Inn.

SM to advise on target date for completion of first draft for design guide.

3. Landscape Character Assessment

Teams now have maps produced by PK. Confirmed target date to complete the fieldwork by end December. Meeting of the LCA volunteers to be arranged for end January.
