

Blisland Neighbourhood Development Plan

Community Action Plan

The Neighbourhood Development Plan encompasses those Parish Issues that are controlled through the Planning Process; throughout the NDP process a series of Parish issues have been identified that should be addressed through the Parish Council and outside the scope of the NDP. These have been incorporated into a Parish Action Plan that will form an Annex to the Adopted Neighbourhood Development Plan; they include:

- a. Renewing the protection of the Village Green verges.
- b. The construction of a Policy to ensure the proper regulation of the installation and management of benches on the Village Green.
- c. A review of the current levels of lighting on, in and around the Village Green.

d. Improvement in the provision of the Village Notice Boards.

e. Improved, and better regulated, signage in the Conservation Area and around the Village Green; specifically addressing the handwritten 'unofficial' signs and maintaining and enhancing the highways fingerposts.

f. A regular policy relating to the annual inspection, care and replacement of the Trees on the Village Green.

g. A regular policy relating the Public Footpath maintenance of the Parish.

h. A review of the Conservation Area Boundary.

i. A review, once the pandemic restrictions have been eased, of the shared use of adjacent Parish's Community Bus & the mechanism for publicising and operating such an arrangement.
